## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The following is the Action Taken Report based on the feedback and suggestions given by the stakeholders—Alumni, Parents/ Guardians, Students and Teachers, on the curriculum, academic and extra-curricular activities, and the ambience of the institution in general for the session 2021-22.

| 1.            | Increase the number of books in the library        | Efforts are made to increase the number of books, both text and reference books in the library every year. Each Department provides a list of books based on the CBCS curriculum for every Semester. Students are encouraged to spend their free time in the library as well.   |
| 2.            | Cleaner Campus                                     | One of our primary aims is to maintain a clean and green campus. In addition to being a plastic-free zone, our campus also has a proper waste management system in place. Dustbins are placed throughout the premises for the use of student and staff. Littering is strongly discouraged. The NSS unit of the college often conducts Campus-Cleaning drives. In addition, sweepers are hired on a temporary basis to clean the premises from time to time.   |
| 3.            | Internet connection for Students                   | Wi-Fi connection has been installed for the usage of students and staff throughout the campus, including the office, staff room, library, and classrooms.   |
| 4.            | Need for a canteen                                 | The institution recognises the need for a canteen for both students and staff. However, being a rural college and other constraints, it has been found difficult to maintain a successfully running canteen. Infrastructural limitation has also proven to be a major hindrance along with a lack of an authentic vendor. That said, efforts are constantly made to establish a canteen within the college premises. We have also received a building grant recently that may be utilised for the same. |
| 5.            | More field trips / excursions                      | So far Departments with field-work / excursions in their curriculum have conducted such tours. However, in recent years, other Departments have been able to organise educational tours as well. Other Departments are also actively encouraged to conduct at least one annual educational tour in future.  |
| 6.            | Need for a more practical & job-centric curriculum | Though the institution strictly adheres to the University prescribed CBCS curriculum, our faculty members who are members of the UG Board of Studies play an active part in framing not only an updated and job-oriented curriculum for the learners but also one with a more holistic approach to the teaching-learning process.   |

| 7.  | The Curriculum could be more ICT based.   | The Feedback received from several teachers has been passed on to the faculty members who are part of the UG Board of Studies of the affiliating University and are directly involved with curriculum planning and design.  |
| 8.  | The Curriculum could be more research-oriented and project-based                        | The curriculum has recently been revised to include more papers on research and presentation.   |
| 9.  | The Curriculum could incorporate topics related to NET/ SET and other competitive exams | The curriculum has recently been revised to incorporate more topics and issues pertinent to competitive exams.  |
| 10. | Need for a gym and store room   | Infrastructural limitation and the lack of grants has been a major hindrance. That said, we have recently received a building grant and have plans for both a gym and an additional store room in near future.  |
| 11. | Need for another cycle stand  | There is one cycle stand for staff and students each. In addition, a vetting process is already underway for a new and bigger cycle stand.  |
| 12. | Repair college-bound road   | The institution had made all efforts to repair one of the college-bound roads, including conducting a staff meeting and formally writing to the Block Development officer, and the local Panchayet. Some repair-work has been done to make the road passable and hazard-free for students and staff.                                |
| 13. | More Parent-Teacher meetings  | We have increased the number of Parent-Teacher meetings from the current semester to keep the parents / guardians apprised of the academic progression and overall development of their respective wards along with note any Feedback they may have regarding the institution.  |
| 14. | Increase number of Faculty members  | The college requires more teaching staff in certain departments and posts have been created for the same. Since the recruitment process is completely managed by the State Government, we have been unable to fill some of the teaching posts. However, the Higher Education Department has already been intimated of this lacking. |
| 15. | Need for Department library   | This is another infrastructural lacking that may be mitigated in near future with the new building grant.   |
